Ken Malik served as Police Chief for Cambridge for the past 13 years, and recently retired after 40 years with the Cambridge PD. Chief Malik started with the Cambridge Police in 1982 as a patrolman. In 1982 he was promoted to sergeant, and by 1987 he had worked his way up to lieutenant. In 2002 he was given the role of Acting Chief, and then to Chief.

"I've just been proud to serve with so many good people over the years," he told the Banner. "If I had any success in my work it was a credit to them, to the great people I worked with, and not to me."

He has always been a strong supporter of Safe Schools initiatives, including the Safe Schools Committee, DARE Program, and emergency crisis assistance, and is a Charter member of the Superintendent's Advisory Council.
